

## CO2 Widget - Brundtland 600

The Brundtland 600 widget is named in honour of Gro Harlem Brundtland, former Prime Minister of Norway. She now serves as a Special Envoy on Climate Change for the United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon.

### Gro Harlem Brundtland

In 1983, Brundtland established and chaired the World Commission on Environment and Development (WCED), widely referred to as the Brundtland Commission, developing the broad political concept of sustainable development in the course of extensive public hearings that were distinguished by their inclusiveness and published its report *Our Common Future* in April 1987. The Brundtland Commission provided momentum for the 1992 Earth Summit/UNCED, that was headed by Canadian Maurice Strong, a prominent member of the Brundtland Commission. The Brundtland Commission also provided momentum for Agenda 21.

### Brundtland 600 Widget | 600 x 500 pixels

This widget displays the current level of CO2 measured directly from the Earth's atmosphere at the Mauna Loa Observatory in Hawaii. It features a graph of the CO2 data set spanning the instrument record for atmospheric CO2 which started in March 1958. Like all CO2 widgets hosted by CO2Now.org, this one is updated monthly as the latest CO2 data is published by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration in the United States.

You can add this widget to your website or blog with the html code below. It is 600 pixels wide and 500 pixels high. The widget at the top of this page is the same widget that people will see when they visit your site.
